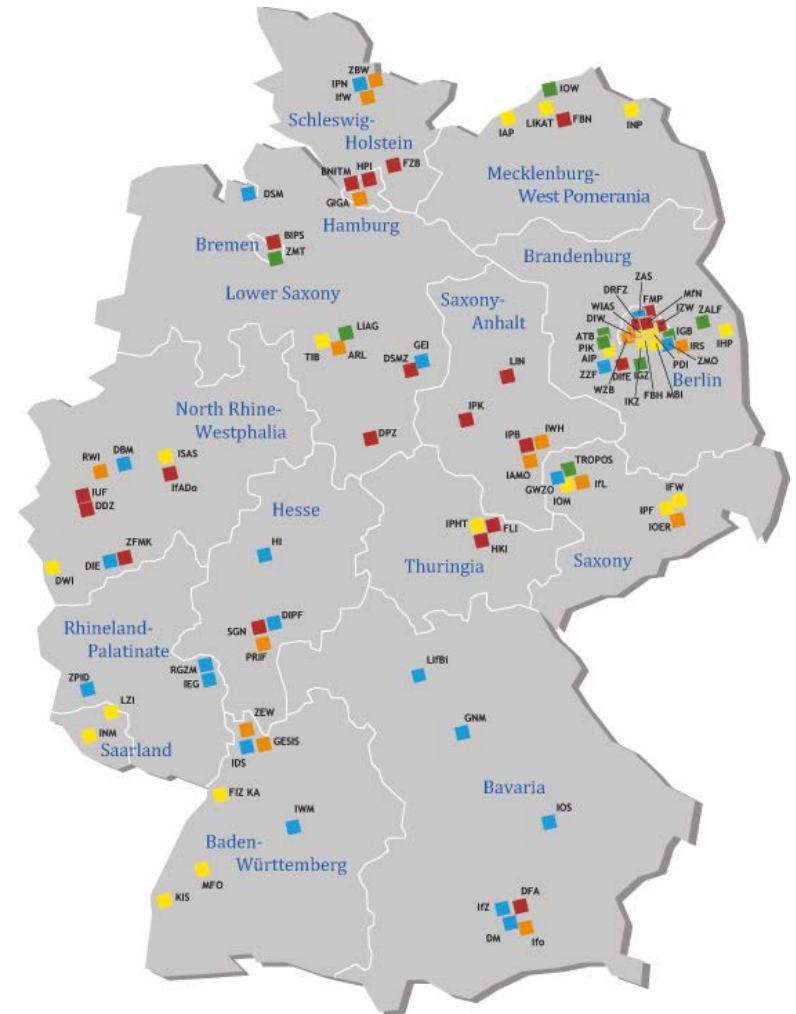

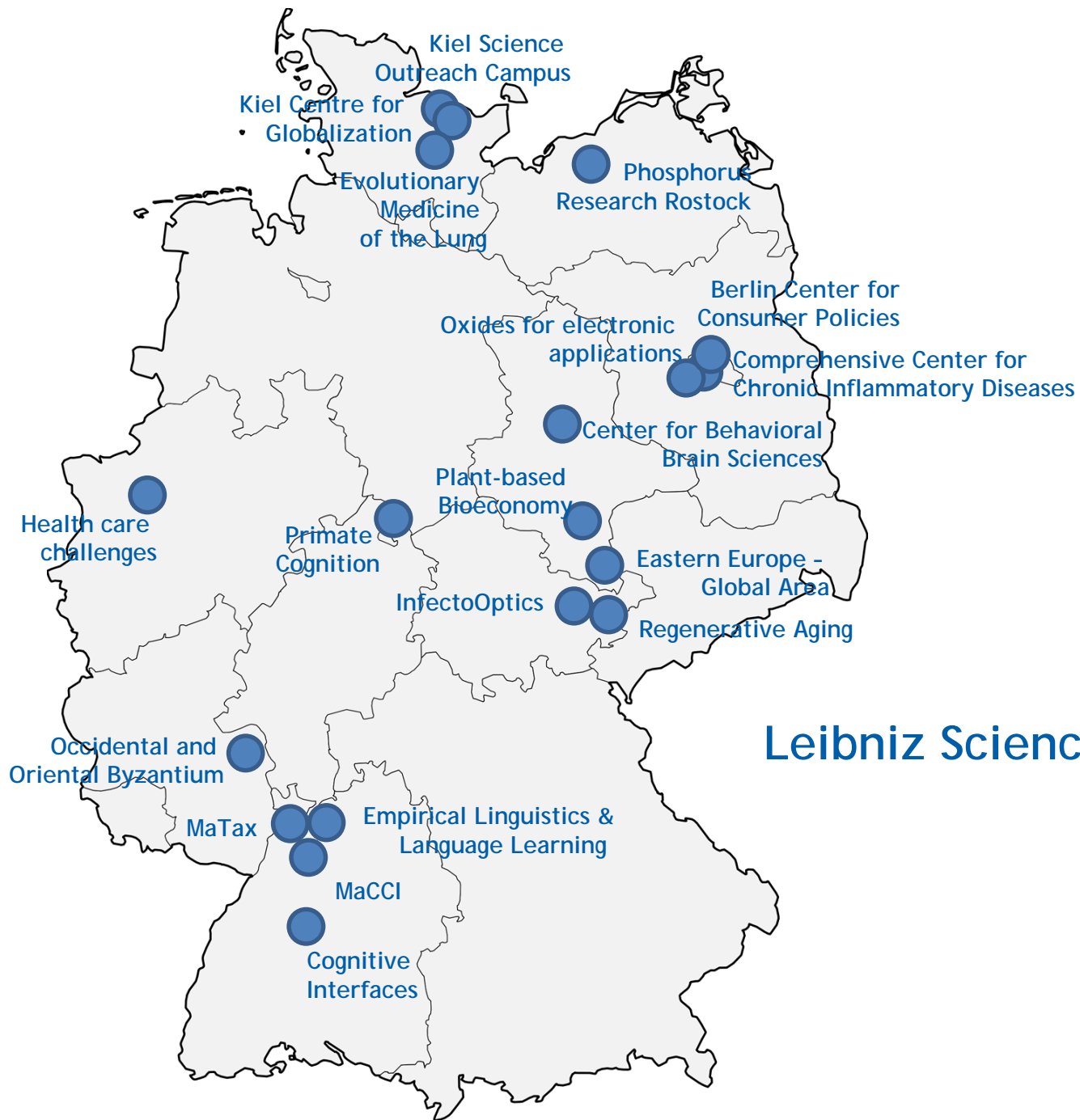

Cooperations in Iran

 - Projects with Iranian Partners (e.g. DSMZ)
